Instructions for connecting to the teleconference:

- At approximately 9:45 am (EST) on the day of the teleconference, assemble participants. If participating as a group use a speakerphone (otherwise a regular handset phone will be fine) to dial the following toll free number:

Session Title: The New S.H.E.A. Models for Training Evaluation

Faculty: Dr. Michael P. Shea

Date: December 18, 2007

Time: 10:00 am to 11:00 am EST

Overview of the Session:

This session will focus on using a seven-level model for evaluating training interventions performed by not-for-profit and public sectors. The S.H.E.A. (2007) model of seven-level training evaluation is adapted from the four-level training evaluation by Kirkpatrick. The four-level model has a solid history in the private sector of contributing to training effectiveness in companies such as IBM, Intel and Motorola. It has also been used in Canada's public sector but less so in the non-profit sector.

The primary goal of this session is to introduce injury prevention practitioners in Ontario and beyond to this revised and improved model for evaluating their injury prevention training interventions in a comprehensive manner.

Learning Objectives:

By the end of these sessions, participants will:

1. Acquire new knowledge with regard to the seven levels of evaluation that are needed in order to comprehensively evaluate an injury prevention training intervention.
2. Understand what is unique about training evaluation in the not-for-profit and public sectors and how this new model reflects these contexts.
3. Learn where to get additional resources and training on how to implement this new model of evaluating injury prevention training interventions.
